

Challenges in data sharing






Insufficient resources (time, budget or knowledge)






Automating data sharing is on the agenda, but the timeline varies




1. What percentage of Dutch organizations share their available data in a structured way?

Structured: the required information can be gathered directly and partially shared in an automated way. Data from third parties can be imported.



27% of the organizations share data in a structured manner






2. Which department is, according to most organizations, responsible for staying informed about upcoming legislation regarding data sharing?



40% indicates that this responsibility lies with the IT department.






3. What is the biggest challenge for organizations regarding the implementation and compliance with new legislation?



Lack of knowledge is biggest challenge






4. What percentage of organizations create an action plan when new legislation is announced?



30% of the organizations create an action plan






5. What percentage of organizations are skeptical about the implementation of new legislation?











What is happening in Europe?
